

Vermont State Parks

Off-Season Access 2009

Region 1	
Park	Access Details
Allis	Gate is open and the town plows to the Ranger's quarters.
Coolidge	Parking is plowed ¼ mile from the entrance. Primary access is via VAST corridor trail through park.
Quechee	Access and parking through Visitor Center.
Mt. Ascutney	Brownsville and Windsor trail heads are plowed. Parking for campground access is provided from a plowed pull-off just outside the entrance.
Wilgus	Parking for foot access is provided from a plowed pull-off just outside the park.
Gifford Woods	Access through the shop area.
Thetford	Plowed parking and access through Thetford Academy.

Region 2	
Park	Access Details
Branbury	Gate is open, access is plowed and portable toilets are provided.
St. Catherine	Gate is open and portable toilets are provided.
Woodford	Plowed parking for significant snowmobile and ski access.
Emerald Lake	Access plowed to maintenance shop area.

Region 3	
Park	Access Details
Alburg Dunes	West gate (Coon Point entrance) is open approximately October 1. East & center gates open for the VAST trail during snowmobile season. East gate (Poor Farm entrance) opens to the beach when frozen for ice-fishing access.
Grand Isle	Open through town road but gate is closed at Route 2. Plowed to contact station.
Knight Point	Gate is open and access is plowed to maintenance shop area. Most of parking lot is plowed for ice fishing & trail access.
Lake Carmi	Gate is open and one bathroom is opened early to accommodate fishing. Plowed to boat launch area for ice fishing access. Campground access road is part of a VAST trail.
Niquette Bay	Gate is open. Entrance & parking lot plowed. Portalet provided in parking lot.
North Hero	Gate is open. Access road usually plowed to day beach & boat launch. Camp loops NOT plowed.
Sand Bar	Gate is open, the parking lot is plowed and portable toilets are provided.
Underhill	Road is plowed to within one mile of the gate, with a turn-around and some parking space provided.

Region 4	
Park	Access Details
Brighton	Open for deer and moose hunting, then gate is closed. There is a vast trail into the park through the gate area.
Crystal Lake	Gate is open and town plows an area around contact station.
Elmore	Lower access is open and plowed for events by organizers. Park is open for deer season.
Green River Reservoir	Upper parking lot is plowed by the town.
Kettle Pond	Parking area is plowed. Relatively high occurrence of winter camping here.
Little River	Gate is open through muzzle loading season, lower parking lot is plowed.
Maidstone	Gate is open for VAST trail, day use parking is open and plowed.
New Discovery	Parking area is plowed. Park is open for deer season.
Seyon	Open
Smugglers' Notch	Park gate is closed but Ski Dorm lot is open for Stone Hut activity.
Groton Nature Center	Parking area is plowed.
Overlook in Groton	Has plowed parking.
Northern Parking Area in Groton	Parking area is plowed.
