







Cabins & Cottages in Vermont State Parks

Ready to get away from it all? Vermont State Parks provide the ideal family or group vacation setting. Our cottages and cabins include the comforts of home but are beautifully situated in lush natural surroundings. Enjoy mountain or lakeside views, canoeing, kayaking, swimming, fishing, hiking and nature walks just to name a few pleasures...all just outside your front door.

Cabins:

Our cabins are cozy one-room units that sleep four people comfortably. All cabins are constructed with the same layout, using native materials. Amenities include bunk beds and a futon or sleeper couch (linens and towels not included) a table and two chairs, an electric outlet, a covered front porch and a fire ring with a cooking grate. Cooking is done outside (bring your own cookware). Bathrooms and showers are located within easy walking distance.

	Brighton State Park, Island Pond - 5 cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night Easy walking distance to the waterfront.
	Gifford Woods State Park, Killington - 4 Cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night All cabins on wooded sites in mature forest. Not a lakefront location.
	Grand Isle State Park, Grand Isle - 4 Cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night Most of these cabins are on the waterfront or have water views.
	Half Moon State Park, Hubbardton - 5 Cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night Two cabins are on the waterfront; three have water views. All are easy water access.
	Lake Carmi State Park, Enosburg Falls - 2 Cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night Both are on the waterfront. Cabin A is pet friendly.
	Ricker Pond State Park, Groton - 5 Cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night All Cabins on wooded sites, two with water views.
	Wilgus State Park, Ascutney - 2 Cabins: VT residents- \$46/night; VT non-residents- \$48/night Both have water views and easy access to the Connecticut River.

Cabins Overview: 4-night minimum if reserved prior to March 1 (in most parks); 2-night minimum if reserved after March 2; no security deposit; no pets (Carmi has one pet-friendly cabin) or smoking; 6 people max (sleeps only 4, so extra 2 either sleep on floor or in tent outside); guests pay park entry fee; 2 vehicles max; wood and ice available for purchase at all parks; cabin should be left clean; check in 2 PM, check out 11 AM (just like campsites).

Cabin Cancellation Policy: If you cancel your reservation prior to 2:00 p.m. on the day before your expected arrival date, you are entitled to a refund of all fees except a \$10 cancellation fee and the \$6 reservation fee paid, per site. If you cancel after 2:00 p.m. on the day before your expected arrival date, or, if you come camping and need to leave prior to the end of your stay, you can receive a refund for the unused portion (except for the required minimum), per site, if you notify the park staff before departing. No refunds will be issued for an unused portion of the required minimum reservation period. If you are charged for the minimum number of nights that were in effect when you made your reservation, then the cancellation fee will not be charged.

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Cottages:

Each of our unique cottages have multiple rooms which sleep four to six comfortably and include all the necessary furnishings, including one to two beds, one or more bunk beds, sleeper couch or futon with pillows and blankets (linens and towels are not included) and bureaus. Each cottage has electricity, heat, indoor kitchen with refrigerator, stove, freezer, toaster oven, microwave, coffee maker, cookware, sink and indoor bathroom with toilet and shower. The common area includes tables and chairs.



Branbury State Park, Salisbury- \$80/night; \$560/week

Screened-in porch, open deck, three bedrooms- one double bed, two twin beds, and a full-size futon



Camp Plymouth State Park, Ludlow- \$80/night; \$560/week

Four cottages available. two bedrooms– one queen size bed, and (2) twin beds or twin bunk beds



Crystal Lake State Park, Barton- \$70/night; \$490/Week

On Crystal Lake, front porch, canoe for your use, one bedroom- double bed, bunk bed, and a sleeper sofa



Half Moon State Park, Hubbardton- \$87/night; \$610/Week

On Half Moon Pond, screened-in porch, deck, boat dock (no motorboats,) one bedroom & loft- double bed, two twin beds, and a full-size futon



Ricker Pond State Park, Groton- \$70/ night; \$490/Week

View of Ricker Pond, very small cottage, *five* people max, one-room-bunk beds and a full-sized bed



Shaftsbury State Park, Shaftsbury- \$80/night; \$560/Week

On Lake Shaftsbury, open porch, canoe, three bedrooms– four twin beds (two in each) and a full-sized bed

Cottages Overview: No pets; no smoking; no tents permitted on grounds; 3 night minimum prior to June 15 and after Labor Day; 7 night minimum June 15 - Labor Day; guests pay park entry fee; \$100 cleaning deposit required; all cottages are located on or close to water; 2 vehicles max; wood and ice available for purchase at most parks (not Crystal Lake or Shaftsbury) Cottage should be left clean, dishes washed, trash and leftovers appropriately bagged for disposal; check in 2 PM, check out 11 AM (just like campsites).

Cottage Cancellation Policy: If you cancel your reservation 30 days or more prior to the first day of your stay, you will receive a full refund less a \$10 cancellation fee; If you cancel your reservation 14 - 29 days prior to the first day of your stay, you will receive a full refund less two nights fee; if you cancel your reservation 14 days or less prior to the first day of your stay, you will receive no refund.
