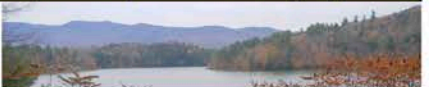


Little River State Park Activities.....September 17th - October 9th, 2022

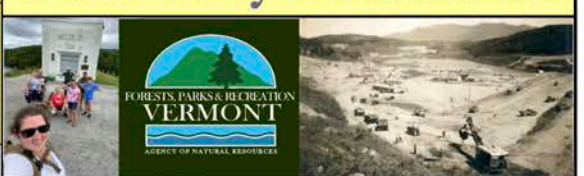

Thunder cancels all programs, rain relocates to Nature Center. Day use visitors should confirm all programs with Park Office 802-244-7103. Please walk from sites if possible & **BRING WATER!**

- **Getting There From Here** - Complete trail, area and weather information services. Where to go in North-central Vermont & beyond, how to get there & what to bring with you. Drop in to see Park Interpreter
- **Jr. Ranger Launchpad & Roundup** - Earn the official badge, advance to higher levels OR become a Jr. Park Naturalist. **Nature Center, 1hr**, materials available by request any time at office.
- **Mushrooms Demystified** - Introducing some fabulous, fearsome and possibly delicious members of the Fungi Kingdom. **Nature Center; Duration: up to 2hrs.**
- **Owl Prowl & Night Ghost Hike** - Become "crepuscular" on a twilight tour of Little River's lost farming settlement ruins. **History Hike Parking, 2hrs**, flashlights & **STURDY FOOTWEAR REQUIRED**.
- **Tour of Waterbury Dam** - How Roosevelt's "Forest Army" used a \$3-billion dollar jobs program to save the Winooski Valley from flooded ruin, one rock at a time. Guided walk with mountain views & historical photos. **Location: Just outside Park Gate, Duration: 1hr.**
- **Tracks, Skins & Skulls** - Make & paint plaster animal tracks as you meet your furbearing friends of Little River. **Option:** Create your own wildlife puppet show while molds dry. **Nature Center, Duration: 1hr.**
